## *The Liturgy of the Word*

*The First Lesson .....Mr. Trevor Bethel*

*Reader : A Reading from the Word of God written in Acts 1:15-26*

15. In those days Peter stood up among the believers (together the crowd numbered about one hundred twenty persons) and said, 16. "Friends, the scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit through David foretold concerning Judas, who became a guide for those who arrested Jesus-- 17. for he was numbered among us and was allotted his share in this ministry." 18. (Now this man acquired a field with the reward of his wickedness; and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his bowels gushed out. 19. This became known to all the residents of Jerusalem, so that the field was called in their language Hakeldama, that is, Field of Blood.) 20. "For it is written in the book of Psalms, 'Let his homestead become desolate, and let there be no one to live in it'; and 'Let another take his position of overseer.'" 21. So one of the men who have accompanied us during all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, 22. beginning from the baptism of John until the day when he was taken up from us-- one of these must become a witness with us to his resurrection." 23. So they proposed two, Joseph called Barsabbas, who was also known as Justus, and Matthias. 24. Then they prayed and said, "Lord, you know everyone's heart. Show us which one of these two you have chosen 25. to take the place in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." 26. And they cast lots for them, and the lot fell on Matthias; and he was added to the eleven apostles.

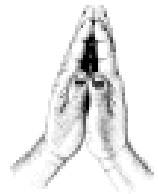

## LIVING AN ABUNDANT LIFE

"First we form habits, and then they form us. Conquer your bad habits or they will conquer you." Rob Gilbert

The "habits" we develop while using our God given wealth will dictate if we find abundance and peace, or scarcity and turmoil. Good habits like having a healthy self image, living within our paycheck, saving on a regular bases and expanding our knowledge will generally lead to financial stability, while bad spending habits can lead to a financial crisis. Therefore, positive habits create the self-reinforcing cycle of increased positive results, but the contrary is also true for negative habits.

It has been said that "Man is a creature of habit". Habit is defined as "A recurrent, often unconscious pattern of behavior that is acquired through frequent repetition". Our lives are made up of a collection of habits that govern how we act physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually.

Most of us know that bad habits ultimately lead to a bad outcome. However, stopping a bad habit is often not easy. This is illustrated well by the quote "Bad habits are like a comfortable bed, easy to get into, but hard to get out of". Studies have shown that we repeat bad habits because they create pleasure in our brains, however temporary.

To change bad habits we must become consciously aware of our God given wealth and any habit that blocks us from enhancing this wealth and ultimately loosing it. We must begin a process called "STOP and PAY ATTENTION". The objective here to try and get us to slow down our lives and really understand how we instinctively react to money matters. A practical tool for changing spending habits is; first journalize our spending behavior for a month, second create a one month spending budget and third act on the budget. As we repeatedly perform these steps we begin to create new positive habits.

Every time through awareness we reject our bad habits and consciously replace them with good habits we strengthen our self image and the process gets easier. In the end we achieve growth in our self image and financial wealth.
